

Health And Safety Of Your Child

School Insurance

All students enrolled in the Oregon School District are insured by First Agency, Inc. This insurance is provided by our Board of Education. Your child is covered by this insurance on the school grounds and in the school building during the hours that school is in session or at any school directed activity. This is accident insurance, not health insurance. Glasses are not covered.

Only the school may report and file a request for benefits. It is imperative that your child report any injury immediately to the teacher and the office. All injuries must be verified and confirmed by the school to qualify for benefits. First treatment must be given within 60 days of the date of injury for a claim to qualify.

First Agency, Inc. is a secondary coverage. In order to determine benefits you must report the accident to your own company if you have other insurance.

Health Services Team

In the best interest of your child we need to be able to reach you or your emergency contact as soon as possible in the event of illness or injury. It is important to pick you child up promptly in case they need medical treatment. Please let the office know if there is a change of phone numbers, workplace, e-mail address or emergency contacts. It is important to have current information in the case of an emergency.
