

"ROUTE TIME FEE"

The "Route time fee" as noted in your co-curricular trip planning examples is defined as follows:

On regular school days, any bus trip which would require the hiring of an additional bus driver during the time in which a routine AM or PM student route was in progress. Times would be prior to 8:00 AM or prior to 4:00 PM. Other examples below.

For example:

- 1) A trip departing at 7:00 AM is considered a route time trip.
- 2) A trip departing at 10:30 AM, returning at 3:00 PM or after is considered a route time trip.
- 3) A trip departing at 3:30 PM is considered a route time trip.
- 4) A trip departing at 11:00 AM and returning at 2:30 PM **would not** be considered a route time trip, therefore no additional charge.
- 5) A trip departing at 7:30 AM and returning at 6:00 PM is considered a route time trip, however there would only be *one fee charged*, even though the bus was out over both AM & PM route times.
