## CIRCLE TIME

Circle Time is a class for all those younger students who especially benefit from keeping with a routine. Many lower elementary classrooms begin their day with a large group activity that often includes calendar, counting and a story. This class will continue that routine and will also provide an opportunity for sensory input while completing arts and crafts, outdoor games and sensory time. Some examples may be gooey art projects, movement games and heavy work through games. This class will be tailored towards the individual student needs.
