

INFORMATION AT A GLANCE

Academic Extension Classes

Some students will be invited to a specific Academic Extension class from their school teacher. If your child receives an invitation, please complete and mail the registration (with payment) to the address shown on the invitation. You can not register online for these classes.

Arrival Time

Children should not arrive at school before 7:45 am.

Attendance

Parents are asked to notify the school when a child will be absent. Please call 835-4291 to report an absence. Attendance is not mandatory, but we want to make sure all children are safe and accounted for. If your child is late for school, have them go to the office and let the secretary know they have arrived.

Band/Orchestra

Please register for Band or Orchestra Lessons online just like the other classes. The schedule forms to request Band or Orchestra time/days can be found at www.oregonsd.org/parents/summer_school.cfm

Behavior

Appropriate behavior is expected from all students. Only students enrolled in summer classes or involved in other school sanctioned activities will be allowed in school facilities.

Bikes/Skateboards/Roller Skates

To avoid a possible bike theft, please use a bike lock and for your safety please wear appropriate safety gear when riding or skating. Roller skates or shoes with hide-a-way wheels are not to be worn in the school buildings. Skateboarding is not allowed in the buildings.

Clothing

Students may wear casual clothing during the summer session, but appropriate dress is expected. Shoes or sandals are required.

Computer Access for Registration

If you do not have access to a computer, the computer lab at Rome Corners Intermediate School will be available March 25th from 6:00pm-8:00pm for online registration

Eligibility for OSD Summer Registration

Anyone living in the Oregon School District or anyone who has attended schools in the OSD through Open Enrollment may enroll in the Summer Activities programs.

Emergency Closing

In case of an emergency closing, an announcement will be made on local radio and TV stations.

Finding Classrooms

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to help his/her child find their way from classroom to classroom and building to building. The teachers and staff are not responsible for this. You are welcome to bring your child to the schools the week of June 21-25 to help them find their classrooms.

Grade Level

Use your child's current 09-10 grade level when choosing classes. Using the wrong grade level could cause your child to miss an opening in a course that is his/her grade level.

Health Concerns

Every effort will be made to accommodate your child's health needs. This information will be given to the office staff and to the appropriate summer school teachers prior to the start of summer school. Parents will be called immediately in the event of an illness or an accident.

Holiday Closing

There will be no summer school activities on Monday, July 5th. There will be swim lessons that day.

Login Information

Everyone starts this 2010 Summer Registration as a new user. Your email address is important. Your password can be any word/number you choose. This system is not part of the Oregon School District PowerSchool system. Like last summer we will open up the system 2 weeks before registration for parents to enter their name, address, phone and student information.

Parking Lot Information

The parking lot and drop off area at Prairie View and Netherwood Knoll can get very congested. Please watch for children darting out into the parking lot. Also, please DO NOT go beyond the cones set up in the parking lot along side Prairie View - **DO NOT** drive over the curb and sidewalk to or from the circle drive to PVE parking lot and **DO NOT** park or leave your car in the circle drop-off area between NKE and PVE. If you need to park use the big parking lot across the street from PVE.

Payment of Summer Activities

Payments by check, cash or e-funds are accepted. Like last summer we will **not** be mailing your confirmation/bill. If you pay by check or cash you are to print, sign the confirmation (summary) page of your child's/children's classes and mail it to the address shown on that page. If your payment hasn't reached us by June 5th we will assume your child has dropped out of the class and their names will be taken off of the class roster. You may pay all activities/all children in one payment with the check made out to Oregon School District.

Refund Policy

Refunds will automatically go in to your child's lunch account. We realize that some children might not have lunch accounts and a check refund will be issued. No refunds or credits will be given for cancellations less than 7 days before the start of the class unless the cancellation is due to a medical or family emergency. Please do not ask for a refund if you didn't give us a full week notice of cancellation. Refunds will not be issued for under \$1.00 and all refunds will be processed after the summer school session ends.

Registration Dates and Time

Online registration will run from Thursday March 25th at 6:00pm and will end Sunday April 25th at 8:00pm It will reopen on Monday May 10th at 8:00am and close Friday May 28th at 8:00am

Requesting Classes online

Only the classes that your child is eligible to take will show up when you are choosing his/her classes. If a class doesn't show up in your child's list of choices that means the class is full, your child is in the wrong grade level or the class was dropped. Check your registration periodically to see if a class that was previously full now has an opening. If it shows up - it has an opening.

Swim Lessons

During the summer the system will allow you to register for more than one swim lesson as long as they don't conflict with other classes. The American Red Cross updated their swim level expectations and ages so if you aren't sure of your child's swim level, please call 835-8617 for assistance.

Transportation

At this time we do not know whether transportation (for a fee) will be provided to those children outside the Village of Oregon. We will let you know closer to registration.

Walk-in registration

The registration system will be re-open May 10th through May 28th. During that time you can check for course openings, swim classes or make necessary changes in your child's registration. Beginning June 1st if you need to make changes you will need to call Nancy at 835-4040 or stop by the pool if you want to register for swim lessons.
