SHARED DECISION MAKING

- 113.01 The Oregon School District Board of Education is committed to site-based and shared decision-making with site council involvement as a decentralized method of operating the school district within defined parameters and staff roles to maximize the effective use of resources in the best interest of students. The goal of site-based and shared decision-making is to create greater accountability and to improve achievement of students toward established district and state standards.
- 113.02 Shared decision-making opportunities shall be made available in the District through a variety of means, including but not limited to the following: committees, councils, and task forces.
- 113.03 The concept of site-based decision-making is entered into with the full and complete understanding that ultimate authority and responsibility for school governance remains with the Board of Education as defined by the state statutes.
