

## **150 DISTRICT LEGAL POLICIES**

### **151 ANNUAL AND SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETINGS**

#### **151.01 ANNUAL MEETINGS**

- 151.01.1 The Annual School District meeting shall be held on the fourth Monday in September at 7:30 PM unless the electors at one Annual Meeting determine a different date or hour. No Annual Meeting may be held before May 15th or after September 30th.
- 151.01.2 Powers of Annual Meeting, The annual meeting may:
1. elect a chairperson and, in the absence of the School District Clerk, elect a person to act as the clerk of the meeting.
  2. adjourn from time to time
  3. vote annual salaries for Board of Education members,
  4. authorize the payment of actual and necessary expenses of a school board member
  5. designate sites for School District schoolhouses and provide for the erection thereon of suitable buildings
  6. authorize the school board to acquire real estate for school district purposes
  7. vote a tax for to purchase or lease sites, building and maintenance,
  8. vote a tax to purchase, operate and maintain transportation,
  9. vote a tax for the operation of the schools of the School District,
  10. vote a tax necessary to discharge any debts or liabilities of the School District,
  11. vote a tax to create a fund for the purpose of paying all current bonded indebtedness for capital expenditures.
  12. vote a tax to create a fund for the purpose of financing all current and future capital expenditures related to buildings and sites,
  13. vote a tax for recreation authority,
  14. authorize the sale of any property belonging to and not needed by the School District,

15. direct and provide for the prosecution or defense of any action in which the school district is interested.
16. authorize the Board of Education to furnish textbooks
17. direct the Board of Education to offer school lunches to the pupils of the School District and appropriate funds for that purpose and/or,
18. direct the Board of Education in other areas as authorized by the statutes.

**151.02 SPECIAL MEETINGS**

- 151.02.1 A special meeting shall be called upon the motion of the Board of Education or upon the written request of 100 electors. [Ref. Wisconsin Statutes 120.8(2)]
- 151.02.2 Powers of a Special Meeting
1. A special meeting has the powers of the Annual Meeting.
  2. Procedures for calling a special meeting can be found in Wisconsin State Statute 120.08 (2)

**151.03 CONSIDERATION OF SPECIAL SUBJECT**

If a least 60 days prior to the Annual Meeting, a petition is filed with the School District Clerk signed by 100 electors requesting that the Annual Meeting consider a special subject or item of business which is a proper subject or item for consideration at the Annual Meeting, the School District Clerk shall incorporate a statement of the subject or item in the notice of the Annual Meeting.

**151.04 VOTING AT SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETINGS**

Every qualified elector of the Oregon School District is eligible to vote at an annual or special meeting of the School District. If a person attempting to vote at the meeting is challenged as to his or her eligibility to vote, the challenge procedure in Wis. Stats. 120.08 (3) will be used.
