

176 STUDENT REPRESENTATION ON THE BOARD OF EDUCATION (replaces 3.03)

176.01 The Board of Education shall include one non-voting student. The student representative shall be a full time District high school student. The student representative shall serve a term from October 1 to September 30. The student representative shall be selected by a process established by the High School administration and Student Council

176.02 The student representative shall:

1. Attend all regularly scheduled board meetings and special sessions when applicable
2. Study board materials and being prepared to discuss items of pupil interests and concerns as requested by the Board
3. Prepare for a follow-up on Board meetings as necessary and report back to the high school
4. Not be involved in Board executive sessions.

176.03 Orientation of Student Representatives

Each outgoing student representative shall assume the responsibility of preparing the new student representative for an active and knowledgeable term, including the following:

1. Transferring all materials and information;
2. Explaining all materials and information;
3. Explaining the Board's role and purpose; and
4. Explaining the student representative's role of the to Board.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for:

1. Extending an invitation to attend all Board meetings prior to officially becoming a student Representative; and
2. Initiating a conference with the student representative and the Board President to present the Board responsibilities of a student representative.
