

8.40 ELIGIBILITY TO ENROLL IN DRIVER EDUCATION

- 8.40.01 Students may enroll in driver education for the first semester of their freshman year providing they are sixteen (16) at the beginning of the school year and have not been referred to Social Services for truancy during the previous semester of eighth grade.
- 8.40.02 Students may enroll in driver education for the second semester of their freshman year providing they are sixteen (16) at the beginning of the second semester. In addition, students must have earned two (2) credits and must have not been referred for truancy during the previous semester.
- 8.40.03 Students may enroll in driver education once they have achieved sophomore status, 4 credits, according to the following age/birth date prerequisites:
- 8.40.03A first semester - age sixteen on or before February 1 of the current school year
 - 8.40.03B second semester - age sixteen on or before September 1 of the next school year
