ParentShare, a volunteer organization dedicated to building a supportive parenting community in the Oregon School District has created a Family Resource Center located upstairs in the kindergarten wing at Netherwood Knoll Elementary School. ParentShares' Family Resource Center is a place where families with children ages 0 to 5 can come to play and learn together, find parenting resources, and connect with other families.

The many different play areas offer something for imaginations of all ages: a play kitchen, blocks, puzzles, listening center, arts and crafts, Lego and train tables, books, infant area, etc. HomeRoom visitors also have access to a parenting resource library and a toy lending library (Toy Share).

HomeRoom hours are: Monday through Friday from 9:00 – 11:00 AM; Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:00 – 8:00 PM. Use the entrances (doors 9 and 10) at the intersection of Spring Street and Grove Street. Enter door 10, the District Services Office door, during school hours. Use door 9 for hours after 3:00 PM.
