

## **317 DEFINITIONS**

### **317.01 SCHOOL YEAR FOR STUDENTS**

- 317.01.1 The Oregon School District shall provide students with at least the minimum days and hours as required by law.
  
- 317.01.2 The superintendent may authorize exceptions.

### **317.02 DEFINITION OF FULL TIME STUDENTS**

- 317.02.1 Full time students are programmed for the school day as defined in Section 8.3.I.
- 317.02.2 Students are required to enroll in a minimum of five (5) classes per day (High School/Middle School).

### **317.03 SPECIAL ITEMS**

- 317.03.1 The individualized education program team may set different standards for students with disabilities through the individualized educational program (IEP) process.
- 317.03.2 High school students may be dismissed for not more than 40% of the day for school-supervised work experience.
- 317.03.3 In addition to classes taken in District, students may take classes at a university, college, VTAE school or other accredited high school as part of the attendance day, which are part of the Youth Options provision of Wisconsin State law.
- 317.03.4 Students who meet the statutory definition of at risk children may attend VTAE schools or other approved programs leading to a high school diploma or high school equivalency diploma in lieu of high school or on a part-time basis. These programs may include: a) modification within the student's current academic program; b) a school-to-work training or work study program; c) homebound study; d) enrollment in day treatment program; e) enrollment in alternative public high school; f) enrollment in home school; or g) enrollment in non-sectarian private school.
- 317.03.5 Building administrators may approve deviations from this schedule in cases of verified physical, mental or personal student needs.
