Village of Oregon Park Shelters

Thank you for your interest in reserving a Village of Oregon park, shelter, and/or playing field. While the Village is excited to open the reservation system it is important to remember that we are still in a global pandemic due to the Coronavirus and everyone needs to do their part to keep our community safe. By making a reservation you understand and agree to the following:

1. All individuals/groups must follow the current order(s), limitations, and guidance from [Public Health Madison & Dane County](#) and the [Center for Disease Control \(CDC\)](#).
2. Masks are required and social distancing must be practiced on any Village property.
3. Be considerate and only reserve time(s) your group/event is going to use the space for. This may allow for multiple requests in a single day.
4. Follow Highlands of Netherwood Park Additional Instructions.

Highlands of Netherwood Park (Additional Instructions)

This is the Village's newest park!

1. At this time the playing field will be available for reservation on Monday & Tuesday (Soccer), Thursday, & Friday (Lacrosse).
2. It will not be available on Wednesdays.
3. All groups/organizations are responsible for removing their equipment/goals so that it is ready for the next group.

Please note when using Park Shelters you must obey the following:

Help keep park spaces safe and open during COVID-19 by practicing the following:

- [Follow Forward Dane Plan's Guidelines](#)
- Stay home if you are ill.
- Maintain at least 6 feet between people outside of your household at all times.
- Do not leave trash behind!
- Bring your own disinfecting materials and hand soap/sanitizer.
- Avoid touching common touch-points (tables and park equipment have not been sanitized by the Village).
- Do not share food or beverages. Avoid having a food buffet, serving food family style or a potluck.
- Consider wearing a face-covering/mask.
- Avoid direct contact with others such as hugs and handshakes.
- Drinking fountains not available.
- Park bathrooms are cleaned once daily (including weekends) by Village Staff.
