What's New?

There has been great progress in the past couple of weeks to the new Forest Edge Elementary School!

CeraClad (fiber cement siding) installation has begun in the west courtyard, the progress will continue through the center and east courtyards as well as the rest of the building exterior. The Geothermal drilling equipment/rig is now onsite, which will kick off the drilling of the bores, a very exciting phase of the project! Additionally, starting on Level 2 in the northwest corner of the building interior, ceiling tile and light fixtures are now being installed, and in the next few weeks will receive carpet and final finishes; and on Level 1 paint and ceiling grid have now started, and drywall is currently being hung at the Administration Office.
