Big changes are happening each day at Forest Edge Elementary School! CeraClad fiber cement panels have now reached installation at the front edge of the building. Geothermal drilling continues at a great pace as well!

On Level 2, ceiling tile and carpet placement is almost complete, and cabinets have begun to be fitted in classrooms!

On Level 1, the walls have color exploding everywhere, and the ceiling grid is making its way around to each classroom.

Carpet and other flooring material will begin in these areas in the upcoming weeks. Additionally, the gym has been painted and equipment has begun to be installed. Kitchen hoods and walk in freezer and fridge have been installed as well.
