Dear Oregon School District Families,

I am writing with an update on this year's Graduation celebration. Last night the Oregon School Board voted to set a target Graduation date of Sunday, July 26, 2020. Mr. Pliner, OHS Principal, and a group of 2020 Graduates made this joint recommendation to the Board.

Graduation was previously scheduled for Sunday, June 14, 2020. Due to the public health emergency order, keeping the June graduation date would eliminate any possibility of an in-person gathering. We know that it is important to our 2020 Graduates, families, and community to hold a gathering, if at all possible.

Public health and safety continues to be our top priority. While the format of graduation will be dependent on public health orders during the scheduled time, setting a target date later in the summer may increase the possibility of an in-person celebration of some sort. The contingency plan is to host a virtual graduation and the July 26 target date will allow time for us to prepare a meaningful virtual graduation, if needed.
