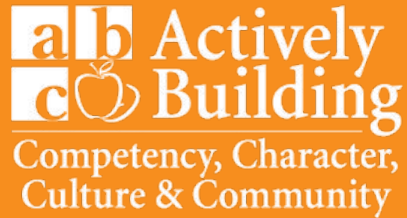

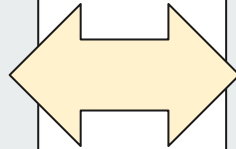

Phased Restart Key Decision Making Criteria

Changing Health Guidance: Schools

PHMDC Order #14: March 10 - April 7, 2021

- Face coverings required.
- Employees maintain at least 6-ft. physical distance.
- When 6-ft. Distance is not possible for students, ensure groups are as static as possible (cohorts) and restrict mixing as much as possible.
- May use common areas (cafeteria, gym) and keep student groupings from mixing.

Tier 1B: Remaining OSD staff, 4K staff, coaches, subs & bus drivers

Educational Model Effectiveness

Our goal is to offer the highest quality instruction for ALL

OSD Approach

1. All students taught by OSD teachers
2. Lessons designed specifically for teaching mode (in-person or online)
3. Responsive teaching / individual engagement



Solution

Grades K-6

Dedicated Phased Restart and Oregon Online teachers

Grades 7-12

Responsive ("flipped") teaching model

Medical Working Group Feedback - Music

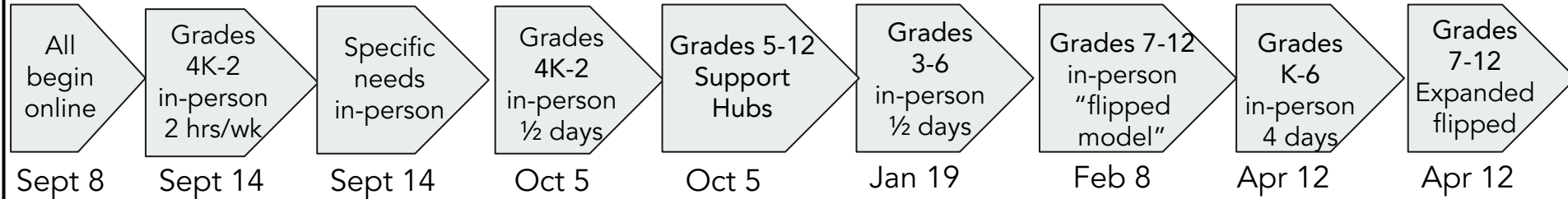
- OHS in-person vocal performance classes to resume on April 5

Oregon Online

Full online learning through the second semester

Next Step: Grades K-6*

- Phased Restart: in-person instruction on Mon, Tues, Thur, and Fri
 - Brooklyn, Forest Edge, Netherwood Knoll, Prairie View: 7:50 am - 2:50 pm
 - Rome Corners: 7:55 am - 2:55 pm
- Oregon Online: Remains online instruction for the remainder of the semester
- *Different OSD teachers for Phased Restart and for Oregon Online

Next Steps: Grades 7-12*

- Phased Restart: in-person instruction for both A & B groups on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
 - OMS: 8:35 am -12:20 pm (Learning hubs in the afternoons)
 - OHS: 8:35 am - 12:30 pm (Learning hubs in the afternoons)
- Oregon Online: Remains synchronous instruction in the afternoons
- *Same OSD teachers for both Phased Restart and Oregon Online
- Wednesdays will continue to be asynchronous learning days for students to allow for individual assistance from teachers, and for teacher collaboration and planning.
