**Question: What efforts might we take to encourage our citizens to work together to keep our students in school?**

Themes:

- Include initiatives to increase engagement with social distancing and COVID safety.
  - Initiatives should motivate students and families and be appropriate based on grade level.
  - Initiatives should be goals that are specific and measurable and don't encourage blaming of others.
  - Initiative goals should include messaging that applies to school and home.
- Have informative and unified messaging to families about COVID safety and vaccine awareness (posters/videos/magnets, etc).
- Increase engagement with OSD families through surveys.
- Informative sessions for parents to ask questions and receive more information.

- Use business mentorship as a method to engage the community.
- Include a plan for Phased Restart students to easily work online if they, or another member of their family is sick.

- Incorporate creative ideas to encourage students to enjoy masks.
- Avoid items families need to purchase.
- Any mask, worn appropriately and approved by PHMDC, is beneficial to wear at school.
