

**NOTICE OF SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION**  
**Oregon School District**  
**April 5, 2022**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that at an election to be held in the Oregon School District, on Tuesday, April 5, 2022, the following offices are to be elected to succeed the present incumbents listed.

The term of office for the school board member in Area I, Seat 1 is one year beginning on Monday, April 20, 2022. The term of office for school board members in Area I, Seat 2 and Area II, Seat 2 is three years beginning on Monday, April 20, 2022.

At a previous annual meeting, the electors established area representation for the Oregon School District and that a prospective candidate must be a legal resident of the Area from which the candidate seeks to represent, and that the offices to be filled at this election and the areas to be represented by the officers elected are below (*see* Appendix A - Election Plan / Boundaries Map). All Oregon School District residents may vote for candidates in each Area and not just the Area in which they reside.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any eligible qualified elector desiring to be a candidate for the office of School Board member must file a Campaign Registration Statement and Declaration of Candidacy stating that the candidate is a qualified elector with the undersigned School District Clerk or designee **not later than 5:00 PM, on Tuesday, January 4, 2022.**

These forms may be obtained at the office of the District Administrator of the Oregon School District located in the School District Services Office, 123 East Grove Street, Oregon, Wisconsin.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** by the undersigned School District Clerk that the Clerk has established this office of the District Administrator as the office for the purpose of filing such campaign registration statements and declarations and that the office of the District Administrator is the proper place for filing such forms. The Office of the District Administrator will be open for receipt of such filing of forms between the hours of 7:30 AM and 4:30 PM weekdays except for holidays and days listed below: November 25 and 26, 2021 and December 23, 24, 27, 28, 29, 30, 2021. Said office **will be open until 5:00 PM on January 4, 2022.**

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, THAT IF A PRIMARY IS NECESSARY, THE PRIMARY WILL BE HELD ON** Tuesday, February 15, 2022.

A description of the school district boundaries is attached as Appendix A and also can be obtained from the school district office.

## OREGON SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION PLAN

On August 22, 2019, at least 100 electors signed and filed a timely petition for:

“the establishment of a plan of apportionment for the Oregon School District Board of Education that has seven board members to be apportioned as follows: Area I would be the Village of Oregon with three seats; Area II would be the City of Fitchburg, Town of Blooming Grove and Town Dunn with two seats; and Area III would be the Town of Rutland, Town of Montrose, Town of Oregon, Village of Brooklyn, Town of Brooklyn, and Town of Union with two seats. The Board terms would be staggered such that no more than three seats are up for election in any given year.”

On September 23, 2019, the electors approved this petition at the annual meeting. Table A represents Oregon School Board seats moving forward. The Board will continue to have seven members as shown below. Prospective candidates must be a legal resident of the Area from which they are seeking election. All Oregon School District residents vote for all Areas, not just the one in which they reside.

Accordingly, as the School District Clerk, I have prepared this election plan before the next election in accordance with Wis.Stat. § 120.02(3).<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Wis.Stat. § 120.02(3) states that the election plan must include:

1. The number of school board members to be elected each year, distributing the number as evenly as possible;
2. The total number of positions to be filled at the first election for 1, 2 or 3 years; and
3. An allocation of the number of candidates to be elected to 1, 2 and 3 year terms at the first election, the 3-year terms to be filled by the appropriate number of candidates receiving the highest number of votes, the 2-year terms to be filled by the appropriate number of candidates receiving the next highest number of votes and the 1-year terms to be filled by the appropriate number of candidates receiving the next highest number of votes.

In April 2020, both seats in Area II shall be up for election. Area II Seat 1 will be a 2-year term and Area II Seat 2 will be a 3-year term. The person receiving the highest number of votes shall serve the 3-year term and the person receiving the next highest number of votes shall serve the 2-year term.

In April 2022, two seats in Area I shall be up for election. Area I Seat 1 will be a 1-year term and Area I Seat 2 will be a 3-year term. The person receiving the highest number of votes shall serve the 3-year term and the person receiving the next highest number of votes shall serve the 1-year term.

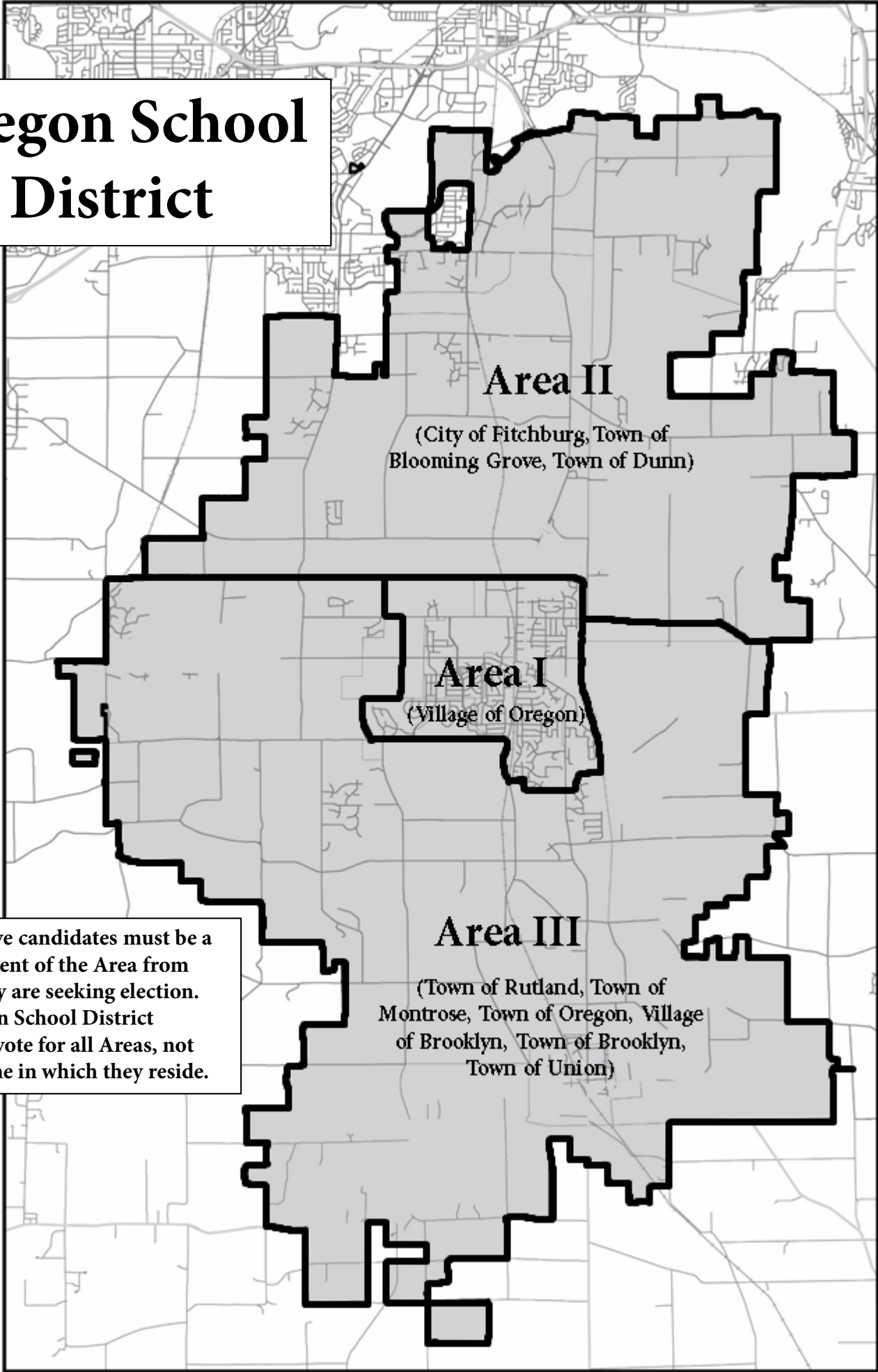
