Lastly, students have been enjoying end of the year field trips! It has been great to see all of the excitement

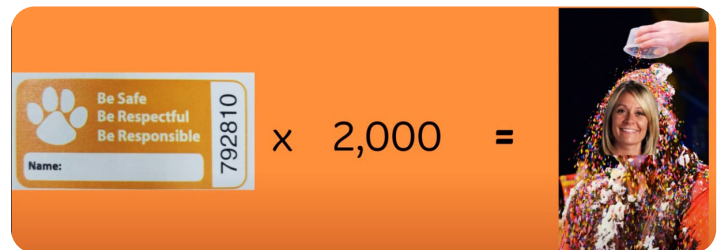


and smiling faces from these experiences. There are a few more grade level field trips in the month of June as well!

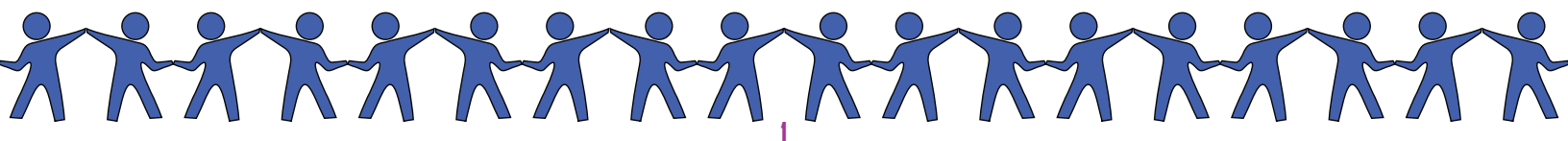
