

Head Lice Policy

- 2.05.01 Any student with live lice shall be excluded from school. The student will be readmitted to school after treatment at home with a lice killing agent and an examination in which no live lice are found. See Administrative Procedure.
- 2.05.02 Any student with eggs (nits) but no live lice will be allowed in school under the following circumstances:
- a. The nits shall be removed and the student shall shampoo with a lice killing agent at home. See Administrative Procedure.
 - b. The student will be examine seven days after the initial treatment.
 1. If nits are present, the student will be required to removed the nits and shampoo again with a lice killing agent.
 2. The student will be re-examined 7 days after the second treatment. If nits are again found, the student will be excluded from school until the student is nit free.
 3. Any student found to have nits three times within a three-month period will be excluded from school until nit free.
- 2.05.03 The District shall inform the parent/guardian of any student found to have lice or nits of the student's status under the requirements of this policy.
- 2.05.04 The District will make reasonable efforts to provide any student excluded from school under this policy with an ongoing educational program as determined by the building administrator in conjunction with the student's teachers.
